

Wednesday May 10 WELCOME TO ISRAEL

- Afternoon/evening arrival at Ben Gurion International Airport in Israel
- Head to Tel Aviv, Israel's "City that Never Sleeps"
- Check-in and <u>cocktail reception</u> and <u>dinner</u> at our hotel

Overnight: Herods Hotel, Tel Aviv

Thursday May 11

"THE CHILDREN SHALL RETURN TO THEIR BORDERS"

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Guided tour at the ANU Museum of the Jewish People on the campus of Tel Aviv University.
- Session with David Nekrutman, Israel Director of the Isaiah Projects, a ministry dedicated to helping Christians discover the Hebraic roots of their faith.



- Lunch on your own at the Sarona Market
- Visit Old Jaffa, the ancient port city mentioned in the Bible as the location from which Jonah attempted to flee from God's mission. Learn about Simon the Tanner and about Peter's vision to preach to Gentiles. Consider the common roots and divergence of Judaism & Christianity
- Learn about Israel's Declaration of Independence which took place in Tel Aviv in May 1948, fulfilling a 2,000-year-old dream of the Jewish People "to be a free nation in our land" which many see as a fulfillment of Biblical prophecy.
- <u>Dinner</u> at West Side Restaurant

Friday May 12

OLD-NEW LAND

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel; pack bus and depart
- Visit the Peres Center for Peace and Innovation to learn about Israel as the "Start-up Nation".
- Wine Tasting at the Bat Shlomo Winery and learn the story of the early Zionist pioneers who founded the community and the winery
- Packed Lunch
- Head to Israel's border with Lebanon. Meet local residents and learn about the security challenges of living on a border Kibbutz.
- Check-in at our hotel on the shores of the Kinneret (Sea of Galilee)
- <u>Shabbat Dinner</u> at the Hotel

Overnight: Isrotel Gomeh Hotel, Sea of Galilee

Saturday May 13 GALILEE OF FAITH

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Head to the Tel Dan Nature Reserve incorporating the headwaters of the Jordan River, the Biblical City Dan and "Abraham's Gate". View Mt. Hermon, likely site of the Transfiguration.

- Visit the archeological park at Magdala the hometown of Mary Magdalene including the 1st Century synagogue
- Lunch on your own
- Head to the Yardenit Baptismal site at the Jordan River. Those who wish to may be baptized
- Sail the Sea of Galilee
- <u>Dinner</u> at the Hotel

Overnight: Isrotel Gomeh Hotel, Sea of Galilee

Sunday May 14

MINISTRY OF JESUS AT THE SEA OF GALILEE

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel; pack bus and depart
- Explore the **Ministry of Jesus** around the Sea of Galilee and learn about Jewish life during the late Second Temple period which is the backdrop and context of the Gospel accounts and the society from which modern Judaism emerged.
- Visit Capernaum the home base of Jesus' ministry including the site of the synagogue where Jesus taught and the home church at what might have been Peter's mother-in-law's house. Consider how a Jewish fishing village became a Christian pilgrimage site.
- Continue to Shomron Samaria in the Biblical Heartland
- Lunch with Hayovel at Har Bracha
- Visit Jewish communities and meet local residents to learn about why they have chosen to live in Samaria in what many call the "West Bank".
- Wine tasting and <u>dinner</u> at the Gvaot Winery

Overnight: Eshel Hashomron Hotel, Ariel

Monday May 15

SHOMRON – THE BIBLICAL HEARTLAND

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- See the Biblical Gardens at Eshel Hashomron which includes a model of the Tabernacle
- Pack bus and depart
- Explore ancient Shiloh which served as the home of the *mishkan* (Tabernacle) and spiritual center of the Tribes of Israel over 3,000 years ago, prior to establishment of the Temple in Jerusalem.
- Meet Byron Stinson and learn about the exciting Red Heifer Project
- Visit the studio of local artist Marc Provisor, who is also the Director of Security Projects at the One Israel Fund.
- <u>Lunch</u> and wine tasting at the <u>Psagot Winery</u> with special guest Sondra Baras, Director of Christian Friends of Israeli Communities (CFOIC).

• Continue to the **Dead Sea** (*the lowest place on earth*) for check in and <u>dinner</u> at the hotel **Overnight:** Leonardo Plaza Hotel, *Dead Sea*

Tuesday May 16

THE PRICE OF FREEDOM

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
 - Morning at leisure to float in the Dead Sea OR
 - Cable car up to Massada where the last Jewish freedom fighters faced the mighty Roman Empire 2,000 years ago. Tour atop the mountain as we address the troubling issues presented by the Masada story.
 - Pack bus and depart hotel
 - Packed Lunch
 - Continue to Hevron visit the Machpelah Complex which marks the burial place of the Biblical Patriarchs & Matriarchs and meet Yishai Fleisher, International Spokesperson for the Jewish





Community of Hevron

- Head to Jerusalem and celebrate our arrival with the magnificent views of the city from the Haas Promenade.
- Check-in at hotel
- Dinner on your own (Lori Hinze will be available to accompany those interested to one of Jerusalem's finest restaurants for dinner on your own as a group)

Wednesday May 17

JERUSALEM THE HOLY THROUGH THE CENTURIES

- Breakfast
- Early morning visit to the Temple Mount
- Step back 3,000 years to the days of King David and to the days of the First Temple at the City of David, (the original Jerusalem) and get an update on the latest archeological finds - which might include the palace of King David.



- Lunch and shopping time on your own in the Old City
- At the **Temple Institute** we will learn about the history of the Holy Temples and gain insight into the Divine promises about Israel's present and future. *Examine the centrality of the Temple experience in Jewish society and tradition past present and future.*
- At the Southern Temple Mount Archeological Park, step back 2,000 years to the days of the Second Temple.
- Private prayer time at the Kotel (Western Wall)
- Dinner on your own (Lori Hinze will be available to accompany those interested to one of Jerusalem's finest restaurants for dinner on your own as a group)

Thursday May 18

FROM OUT OF THE CRUCIBLE

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Stand in solemn memory at Israel's Yad Vashem memorial to the Holocaust including the historical museum and the children's memorial.
- Lunch at Yad Vashem
- Visit Arugot Farm at the edge of the Judean Desert
- Return to Jerusalem and visit the Friends of Zion Museum which tells the story of Christians who have helped make the restoration of the Jewish people in Israel a reality
- Dinner on your own (Lori Hinze will be available to accompany those interested to one of Jerusalem's finest restaurants for dinner on your own as a group
- Join Yom Yerushalayim (Jerusalem Day) Celebrations marking 56 years since the reunification of the city

Friday May 19

JERUSALEM DAY – YOM YERUSHALAYIM

- <u>Breakfast</u> at the hotel
- Morning at leisure to explore the city on your own and join in the celebrations!
- Celebrate the vitality of life in Jerusalem at the open air Machaneh
 Yehudah Shuk market where we will explore together and purchase lunch on your own

In the early evening we'll greet the Sabbath and enjoy a home hospitality <u>Shabbat Dinner</u>

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Shabbat morning prayer services at a Jerusalem synagogue
- Communion at the Garden Tomb, remembering the Crucifixion and Resurrection in a beautiful garden setting recalling "the place of the skull" (Golgotha).
- Farewell Shabbat Lunch
- Time to relax and pack and to explore the city on your own before heading to Ben Gurion International Airport for flights to the USA
